

Spelling plays a very important role in written communication. When there are spelling errors, the effectiveness of a written message, however well it is written, gets diluted and there is a danger of the readers forming a poor impression of the writer's ability and competence. For example, a good student student will tend to get poor marks if his/her answer is full of spelling errors. Therefore it is essential for you to learn to write without spellings errors. Firstly, in our languages, the writing system is close to pronunciation. But in English there are 26 letters corresponding to 44 sounds. This sometimes creates confusion. Secondly English has borrowed many words from French, Latin, German and other European languages which have their own eccentric spelling. Thirdly, there are many words which contain silent letters. That is, some of the letters in words are not pronounced while speaking. So the way they are spoken and the way they are written are sometimes different.
